

Identity columns

- A new entry in Oracle® Database 12c - Appendix B

Clean your test environment.

```
CONRAD@orc1> set timing off
```

If you want to drop the whole test environment:

```
SYS@orc1> DROP USER CONRAD CASCADE;
```

User dropped.

```
SYS@orc1> DROP TABLESPACE CONRAD_TAB INCLUDING CONTENTS AND DATAFILES;
```

Tablespace dropped.

```
SYS@orc1>
```

Otherwise, if you want to drop the Objects only, but not the User and the Tablespace:

```
CONRAD@orc1> DROP TABLE T1 PURGE;
```

Table dropped.

```
CONRAD@orc1> DROP TABLE T2 PURGE;
```

Table dropped.

```
CONRAD@orc1> DROP TABLE T3 PURGE;
```

Table dropped.

```
CONRAD@orc1> DROP TABLE T4 PURGE;
```

Table dropped.

```
CONRAD@orc1> DROP SEQUENCE SEQ_T1_ID1;
```

Sequence dropped.

```
CONRAD@orc1> DROP SEQUENCE SEQ_T2_ID2;
```

Sequence dropped.

```
CONRAD@orc1> DROP SEQUENCE SEQ_T3_ID3;
```

Sequence dropped.

```
CONRAD@orc1>
```

And, finally, you can disconnect your session.
